What is PAF?

- The Postcode Address File (PAF®) is Royal Mail's database of UK postal addresses and Postcodes.
- PAF contains 29.7 million residential and business postal addresses and all 1.8 million Postcodes. It also includes more than 1.4 million business names and details of vacant properties.
- PAF is the UK's most up to date and widely used address database.
- We're committed to maintain its accuracy, in fact we update thousands of records each day.




Creating new addresses and assigning new Postcodes


Royal Mail works closely with every single UK Local Authority.




We support planning departments with defining street names and addresses for all new properties.

Our postmen and women...



walk every street in the UK, six days a week.



The address changes they capture contribute to us making between 4,000 and 5,000 changes each day or around 1.4 million updates to PAF each year.



Postcodes have become part of the UK's social fabric

92% of UK residents find it easy to remember their Postcode

Postcodes are more memorable than other personal information such as bank account details, birthdays and pin codes. Ipsos MORI, February 2016.

- Postcodes were first introduced in the UK in 1957 and by the end of 1974 had been rolled out nationally.
- The simple combination of alpha-numerics has aided their memorability and in turn cemented their place in our social consciousness.
- They were originally designed to help facilitate the efficient and effective delivery of mail.
- Their use has evolved and they are now widely used by organisations across the public and private sectors.

We have other address databases that add detail to PAF



A database of 185,000 postal addresses where the property has two or more individual dwellings that share a single letter box. The file contains details of 750,000 individual multiple residences.

Database is used to identify suitable delivery options and reduce risk of fraud.

Not Yet Built contains details of 485,000 properties that are in the planning or construction stage. We add 25k new records to this database every month. Once delivery point can receive mail, the record is transferred to PAF.


Using Not Yet Built enables organisations to accept orders from new owners before the property is occupied.

Some addresses use alternative details to those held in PAF, such as a property name rather than number or a county name, and this information is held in our Alias file.

It's easy for citizens to access address and Postcode information



- Citizens can access address and Postcode information via Royal Mail's online Postcode Finder application.
- The application can be accessed on a desktop or via a mobile device.
- Users can lookup 50 addresses every day.
- There are approximately 5 million completed searches on Postcode Finder every month.




